

# EXPLANATION OF WAGERING

**WIN-** Your greyhound must finish first, and you collect the win payout . (Minimum wager - \$2.00).

**PLACE** - Your greyhound must finish either first or second, and you collect the place payout.(Minimum wager - \$2.00).

**SHOW** - Your greyhound must finish either first, second, or third, you collect the show payout. (Minimum wager - \$2.00).

**DAILY DOUBLE** - You must select the winning greyhounds of the first and second races. Daily Double wagers must be made before the first race. (Minimum wager - \$2.00).

**QUINIELA** - You must select the two greyhounds that finish first and second in any order. (Minimum wager - \$2.00).

**QUINIELA BOX** - You must select three (or more) greyhounds you think have the best chance of finishing first and second. If two of your greyhounds finish first and second in either order, you collect the Quiniela payout. Total costs based on a \$2.00 wager.

3 Greyhounds	\$6.00	6 Greyhounds	\$30.00
4 Greyhounds	\$12.00	7 Greyhounds	\$42.00
5 Greyhounds	\$20.00	8 Greyhounds	\$56.00

**QUINIELA WHEEL** - You must select the greyhound you think has the best chance of finishing first or second and tell the clerk to Quiniela Wheel that greyhound (with all other greyhounds). If your greyhound finishes first or second regardless of any other finisher, you collect the Quiniela payout. Based on a \$2.00 wager, Quiniela Wheel=\$14.00

**QUINIELA DOUBLE** - You must select the Quiniela in the two successive races indicated as the Quiniela Double races making both selections before the start of the first race. This special wager is not associated with a regular Quiniela wager on an individual race. (Minimum wager - \$2.00)

**PERFECTA** - You must select the first two finishers in the race in exact order. For example, if you order a 3-2 perfecta, the #3 greyhound must win and the number #2 greyhound must finish second. Minimum wager \$2.00

**TRIFECTA** - You must select the three greyhounds that finish first, second, and third in exact order. (Minimum wager \$1.00).

**\$1 TRIFECTA BOX** - You must select three (or more) greyhounds you think have the best chance of finishing first, second, and third. Because this is a multiple wager, the greyhounds can finish in any order. If three of the greyhounds you have boxed finish first, second, and third, you are a WINNER. The \$1.00 Trifecta Box pays one-half the \$2 Trifecta price. Total costs:

3 Greyhounds	6	Combinations	\$6.00
4 Greyhounds	24	Combinations	\$24.00
5 Greyhounds	60	Combinations	\$60.00
6 Greyhounds	120	Combinations	\$120.00
7 Greyhounds	210	Combinations	\$210.00
8 Greyhounds	336	Combinations	\$336.00

**\$1 TRIFECTA WHEEL** - You must select the greyhound that you feel has the best chance of finishing first, and tell the clerk to wheel that greyhound on top, with all other greyhounds. If your greyhound finishes first, regardless of any other finisher, you collect one-half the \$2.00 Trifecta price (\$1 Trifecta Wheel=\$42). You may also wheel your greyhound in the second or third position. That greyhound must finish in the exact position specified, the finish of all others does not matter.

**\$1 TRIFECTA KEY** - You must select the key greyhound that you think will win and then select two (or more) others that you think have the best chance of finishing second and third, in either order: The \$1 Trifecta Key pays one-half the \$2 Trifecta price. Total costs:

(KEY 1 GREYHOUND WITH)

2 Others	\$2.00	5 Others	\$20.00
3 Others	\$6.00	6 Others	\$30.00
4 Others	\$12.00	7 Others	\$42.00

Also note: You may also "Key" a greyhound in the second or third position. The "key" greyhound must finish in the exact position specified, the others must complete the trifecta, in either position.

**SUPERFECTA** - You must select the four greyhounds that finish first, second, third, and fourth in exact order. (Minimum wager \$1.00). Superfecta's sold in 10 cent increments with a total wager minimum of \$1.00 will be offered at self service machines only.

**\$1.00 SUPERFECTA BOX** - You must select the four (or more) greyhounds you think have the best chance of finishing first, second, third, and fourth. Like the \$1.00 Trifecta Box, the \$1.00 Superfecta Box pays one-half the \$2.00 Superfecta price. Total costs:

4 Greyhounds	24	Combinations	\$24.00
5 Greyhounds	120	Combinations	\$120.00
6 Greyhounds	360	Combinations	\$360.00
7 Greyhounds	840	Combinations	\$840.00
8 Greyhounds	1680	Combinations	\$1680.00

**\$1 SUPERFECTA KEY** - You must select the "Key" greyhound you think will win, and then select three (or more) others that you think have the best chance of rounding out the Superfecta. The \$1.00 Superfecta Key pays one-half the \$2.00 Superfecta price. Total costs:

Key 1 Greyhound with 3 others	\$6.00
Key 1 Greyhound with 4 others	\$24.00
Key 1 Greyhound with 5 others	\$60.00
Key 1 Greyhound with 6 others	\$120.00
Key 1 Greyhound with 7 others	\$210.00

**PIC-3** - You must select the winning greyhounds in the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd leg of each Pic 3. All wagers must be made before the running of the 1st leg. (Minimum wager, \$2.00).

**TWIN-TRI** - (Trifecta-Trifecta) This is a wager combining a trifecta selection in the 11th race (1st half) and Another trifecta selection in the 13th race (2nd half) . The Twin-Tri is a carryover pool. 50% of the Twin-Tri pool is paid out in the 11th race to the winning ticket holders who picked the exact order of finish in the 1st half (3 runners in exact order). The remaining 50% carried over to the second half. If you are a winner in the first half you will receive a pay out for the first half and a free exchange ticket for the second half. The second half is also a trifecta, 3 runners in exact order. Holders of winning tickets on the second half will collect the second part of the pool plus the jackpot carried over from previous Twin-Tri pools. If there are no winners the pool will be carried over to the next days performance. The carryover will be capped at \$25,000. The jackpot pool will be paid the second performance after its capped. This is a \$2.00 minimum wager. Should you fail to cash your first half winning ticket before the running of the 13th race (2nd half) you will receive the first half payoff but will forfeit your chance at the jackpot. All wagers must be placed before the 11th race.

**TRI-SUPER** - (Trifecta-Superfecta). This is a wager combining a trifecta selection in the 5th race (1st half) and a superfecta selection in the 7th race (2nd half) The Tri-Super is a carryover pool . 50% of the Tri-Super pool is paid out in the 5th race to the winning ticket holders who picked the exact order of finish in the trifecta portion of the wager (1st half). The remaining 50% carried over to the superfecta portion of the wager (2nd half) If you are a winner in the first half you will receive a pay out for the first half and a free exchange ticket for the second half . The second half is a superfecta wager that requires picking four runners in the exact order of finish. Holders of winning tickets on the second half of the Tri-Super wager will collect the second part of the pool plus the jackpot pool carried over from previous Tri-Supers. If there are no winners the pool will be carried over to the next days performance. The carryover pool will be capped at \$25,000. The jackpot pool will be paid out the second performance after its capped. This is a \$2.00 minimum wager. Should you fail to cash your first half winning ticket before the running of the 7th race (2nd half) you will receive the first half payoff but will forfeit your chance at the jackpot. All wagers must be placed before the 5th race.
